on the spot with modern drugs and recovered.

During the operation a young woman who had suffered a miscarriage was found. Capt. White decided her only chance was in a hospital treatment.

The Battalion commanding officer, Lieutenant-Colonel A. A. Warr, ordered in an Aus-

tralian Army Sioux helicopter, which airlifted her some miles to Baria, from where she was taken to Vung Tau in an R.A.A.F. Iroquois helicopter.

A 10-year-old boy who was discovered with a paralysed left arm, may regain the use of it because of Australian doctors. His father told

them his arm had been useless since February when it had been struck by shrapnel during a clash between Viet Cong and South Vietnamese troops.

The boy, with his grandmother, was taken to Vung Tau where he was further examined by Lieutenant-Colonel W. Rogers, commanding

officer of 2nd Field Ambulance.

Colonel Rogers decided that with an operation the boy might recover, and arranged his entry into hospital.

Because of the high rate of tuberculosis in the area, mass X-rays of the villagers were arranged.

Twice, while the opera-

tion continued, 5th Battalion trucks journeyed into Baria with men, women and children who doctors decided were TB suspects. More than 80 were examined, and treatment will follow for many.

Treating the people of Binh Ba has become a number one target for Task Force doctors. In

just one day, more than 900 were examined at 1,200 during the 11-day operation.
