

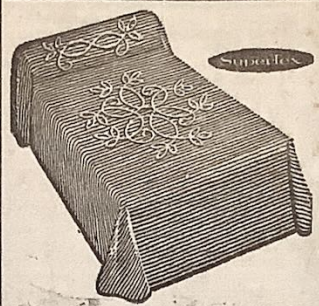

Balmain fights on

More than 150 people were present at last Thursday's general meeting of the Balmain Association. The first important question under discussion was the next steps to be taken in the battle to save the suburb from the deterioration which must result if the Maritime Services Board and the Esso Company proceed with their plans. Members were told of the Leichhardt Council's scheme to carry out a letter-box referendum throughout the area west of Victoria Road; every elector will be given details of the container wharfage and Esso proposals and asked whether or not they support the Council's action against these proposals. Volunteers were called to collect the slips from the residents and more than 70 people offered their help.

Volunteers were also called to distribute leaflets to motorists held up in traffic jams in Victoria Road. The leaflets will point out how very much worse the hold-ups will be if the container wharfage plans go through and up to 3,000 trucks a week are entering and leaving the Balmain peninsula. Motorists using Victoria Road will be asked to add their protests to those already being made by Balmain's residents.

Rates Meeting
 The second question of vital interest to residents was the new rates and a resolution was passed that the Association should sponsor a

public meeting to discuss the situation fully. This meeting will be held in the Balmain Town Hall, on Tuesday, 28th February, at 8 p.m. Members present were reminded that although the rate notices quote 26th February as the final day for payment, interest does not accrue until after the end of May.
