## **Flectrical Fatalities** During 1967

There were 20 deaths from electric shock during 1967. This was 14 fewer than in 1966, and it was the lowest number in any year since 1943, when there were also 20 deaths.

These figures were re-leased by Mr. F. H. Campbell, Chairman of The Electricity Author-ity of New South Wales.
