



First, then-there are materials which naturally have a measure of resistance; wool, for instance, though it may cost more than some of the others. An alternative is to use garments made of the British flame - proof materials (obtainable at some of our leading stores).

Further . . . consider the style of clothing itself. Note that flowing garments, such as the night dress and dressing gown, are more risky than would be those of the same materials cut to cling close to the body. For this reason the track suit style has become popular in Britain.

With all these precautions should go education, of both children and adults, in avoidance of risk . . . the match or the cigarette butt dropped or thrown away while still alight or smouldering: the near approach (even without direct contact) to a glowing radiator; the wood in the grate which has no firescreen, against either a fall or a spark thrown
