

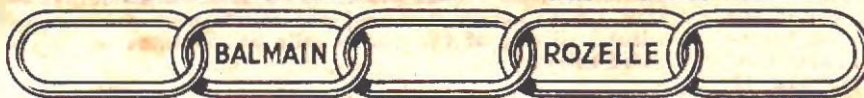

# IRON COVE SILT PROBLEM

Balmain-Rozelle district residents are closely interested in the question of removing the siltation of Iron Cove and Hawthorne Canal, which has offensive results at low tide in the Harbour.

The subject came before Leichhardt Council at its meeting last week, when a reply from the Maritime Services Board to Council representations was reported.

The Council, in cooperation with the Councils of Drummoyne and Ashfield, had asked the Board for assistance in the dredging of siltation in Iron Cove and Hawthorne Canal, to enable the washing away of matter which now collected at low-water level. The matter, in the form of garbage, offal, etc., smelt offensively.

The Maritime Services Board replied that it had no statutory obligation to dredge areas of the Harbour not used by shipping or for commercial purposes. Most of the siltation had been caused from the land.

## Awareness

However, it was aware of the extent of the siltation, and was not averse to entering into discussion with the Council and the Water Board to see whether a selective dredging programme could be undertaken, with cost apportioned on some agreed basis.

It is believed that the cost of the dredging

would approximate \$500,000.

The situation will no doubt be affected, at least on a long-term basis, by the Hawthorne Canal improvement plan. This was the subject of many negotiations between the Water Board, Maritime Services Board, and Ashfield and Leichhardt Councils.

## Canal Work

The section of the canal downstream from Marion Street was constructed nearly 50 years ago, and it became a continuing problem because of siltation, dumping of rubbish and the breeding of vermin.

The work to be carried out by the Water Board consists of a new 3,200 ft. western embankment in stone ballast downstream from Marion Street, and dredging the remaining bed of the canal just below low water level.

The work is expected to take two years, and will be paid for by the Water Board (\$200,000), M.S.B. (\$100,000), and Leichhardt and Ashfield Councils (\$50,000 each).

Residents fronting Iron Cove naturally want to know why they should have to put up with any offensiveness which

would stem from inland areas, especially outside their own municipality.

They would, of course, have to recognise any responsibility for purely local conditions, especially in the form of their own refuse adding to the problem.

This in fact is the sort of situation faced by other harbourside and some seaside communities (such as those affected by ocean dispatch of sewerage).

## Liability

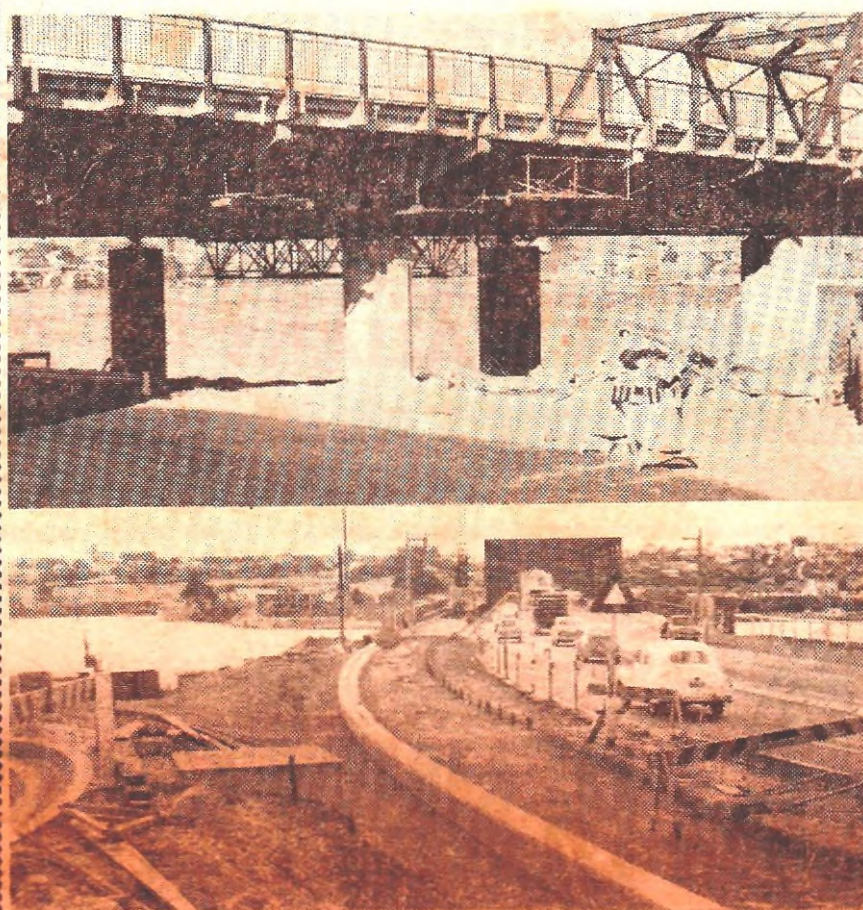
With every justification residents of such localities say that removal of the problem is partly the responsibility of other areas and of the central authorities.

The Hawthorne Canal work should help in the future to improve conditions in Iron Cove.

The M.S.B. points out that it already makes a general contribution to Sydney Harbour siltation removal, by contributing \$5,000 a year for this purpose.

This newspaper considers it gratifying that the Board is willing to enter into discussions which could result in assistance to Leichhardt Council ratepayers in mitigating the nuisance in Iron Cove.

## Fifth Lane On Bridge



From today—Wednesday, October 23, at 2 p.m.—an additional traffic lane is being made available on Iron Cove Bridge.

The widening provides five lanes for use by motor vehicles. Three are for motorists travelling to the city between 6.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. weekdays. At all other times, including weekends, three lanes are available for traffic proceeding from the city.

The firm of Moy Bros. Pty. Ltd. carried out the work for the

Department of Main Roads at a contract price of \$216,967. Widening of the bridge abutments and approaches was carried out by the Department itself, at a cost of approximately \$80,000.

The Department has also constructed an underpass at the Drummoyne end of the bridge to connect Henley Drive and Cary Street, to eliminate crossing of Victoria Road at this point by vehicles and pedestrians.

## Column NINE

### BLUNDERS!!

Recently Mr. Justice Else - Mitchell commented on the short-sighted policy of Leichhardt Council and a need for vigilance in suburban planning.

Many people of much lower station in life are aware that Balmain and Rozelle are like the shag on the rock: out on a peninsula, in a forgotten neck of the Leichhardt woods.

Shortly, municipal elections will be held, and the way to change this short-sighted policy is to inject some new blood and enthusiasm into Council.

An 8½-acre area of prime waterfront land is for sale in Terry Street, Rozelle, which would provide wonderful living for thousands of people. Most importantly, this is probably the last large parcel of land left in this area.

Is it to be scarred by more industry, or will this Council wake from its slumber and realise that Balmain and Rozelle are suffering from a deficiency — a deficiency of people?

To name one progressive step that Leichhardt Council has implemented for this area would probably be the only one. Administering your suburb is a big job. It needs people with forethought and ability, and it must be free of party ties.

For too long have these suburbs been the political football for a party, and for far too long have they been neglected. Lack of planning—lack of forethought—lack of local interest—lack of enthusiasm! These are but a few of the things that need changing.

The need is for a Council that will develop and re-plan these tradition suburbs or suffer the consequences of creeping industrial paralysis.

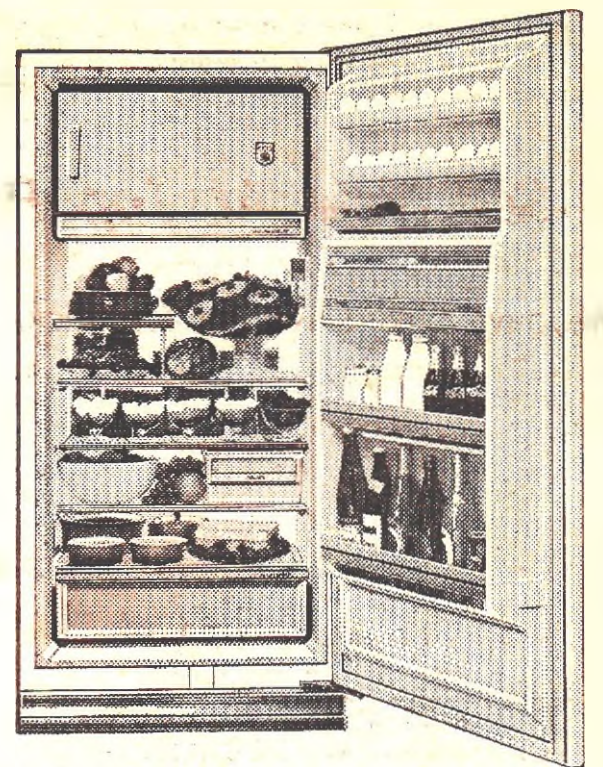

# INDEPENDENT CANDIDATE

Mr. T. A. (Tom) Middleton, J.P., general sales manager of a large public company, who lives at 97 Louisa Rd., Birchgrove, told "The Link" this week that he will be standing as an independent candidate at the forthcoming Leichhardt Council election.

He said he had never been a member of any political party, and considered the problems of the district with true objectivity. However, he loved Balmain and everything about it.

"Four generations of my family have lived in Balmain/Rozelle, and we are proud of it," he said. "The big job ahead of us is to stop the old 'Balmainites' from moving away—give them a reason for wanting to stay. In addition, we have to change our old habits and ideas so that we may get together with our new 'In' neighbours."

Mr. Middleton qualified by examination to the Australian Society of Accountants, Australasian Institute of Cost Accountants, and Chartered Institute of Secretaries, and is an Associate of the Australian Institute of Management and the Institute of Sales and Marketing Executives.

He said he hoped that a number of citizens with

the same sense of independence would submit their names to the ballot also.

"There have been too many examples of negative, unenthusiastic and misguided decisions by this Council," said Mr. Middleton, "and anyone who has pride in Balmain must surely want to do something to reverse these circumstances."

"The ever-changing situation in which Balmain finds itself seems to present too much of a challenge to our Council and its piecemeal, 'hit-or-miss' approach. We need dynamic leadership with bold decisions and the implementation of a sensible overall plan for the rehabilitation of our suburb."

Mr. Middleton said the things he would work for if elected included:

- Protect the interests and express the wishes of the majority of the people in the ward (and not only one group).
- Agitate for Council

to formulate orderly, practical and cogent plans for complete redevelopment and revitalising of the district. It was not nearly enough to have a map which defined the different zoning areas. If necessary, Council itself must initiate, invite and encourage schemes which would bring progress, purpose and prosperity to Balmain.

- Insist that industrial development was confined to areas which were defined for it, without leakage into other areas set aside for residential purposes.

- Fight for library facilities to be made available urgently. About 80% of local authorities in N.S.W. provided some library facilities, but Balmain was supposed to be back in the Middle Ages, where the "peasants" had to be told what was good for them.

- Prevent further encroachment of the waterfront.

- Encourage more community interests, such as arts, music, etc.

Mr. Middleton said he was no relation of Mr. Peter Middleton, Liberal Party candidate at the last State election.

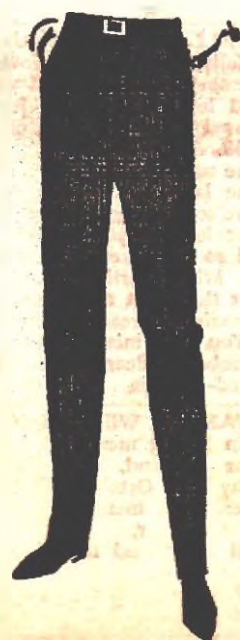
