## MORE FLIISS LIKELY

An increase in the fly population could be expected following the recent warm, moist weather, the Department of Public Health said this week.
The Department's Chief Health Inspector Mr. Harry Evans, said that improved sanitation was the first step in fly control.
Insecticides should be used to supplement but never to substitute for sanitation.
The yard should be clean and free of decaying vegetation and readily in decaying ver etable matter and compost.
Grease traps should be kept clean, and garbage kept in a container with a firmly fitting lid. All garbage should be wrapped in newspaper before being put into the bin.
If a pan closet was kept on the premises. place a half cupful of kerosene in each pan immediately it was received.
Immediately kill any flies which got into the house.
