The death has occurred of Samuel Cooper, one of Balmain's oldest, most widely known and best-loved identities.

Mr Cooper, who served with the Royal Navy for Queen Victoria in her sailing ships, passed away on January 9 at the grand age of 92. He is also a Balmain man. He was a member of the club for ten years.

# Balmain Terminal Problems Are Persisting

Time has brought no sign of easing of tension over noises from the White Bay container terminal. Further complaints from the public have been accompanied by at least one other instance of bad feeling between local residents and the terminal operators.

Complaints regarding conditions continue to be received from residents by the Balmain police.

Resentment came to a head again the weekend before last, when the police were called to the terminal to investigate a report that a couple of half bricks had been thrown over the fence of the terminal from the street above.

One came close to one of the cars parked inside the terminal.

Police patrols took up positions for several hours in the area, but

there were no further signs of trouble.

Inspector L. Dingwell, acting officer-in-charge of Balmain police, said that that type of action was very foolish. It could result in somebody being seriously injured or even killed.

"Of course there must be sympathy for residents who are worried by the noise at night", he said. "People must have their rest."

"However, the situation must not deteriorate into action like this".

Observers report that

the White Bay terminal traffic recently has been very heavy, probably the heaviest since the enterprise commenced.

Diesel trains carrying containers are moving frequently, and altogether the noise is reported to be "frightening", in the words of one commentator.

## Mort Bay

Similarly, the container traffic by road to and from Mort Bay continues to be heavy, producing difficult conditions in the narrow streets in the neighbourhood of the A.N.L. terminal.

Last Wednesday the police investigated a collision between a container-carrying semi-trailer and another vehicle at the intersection of Mort and Church Streets.

The damage was only minor, and nobody was injured.

The Mayor of Leichhardt, Ald. L. J. Rodwell, told Ald. I. Wyner (Balmain ward) at a recent meeting of Council that he would see the traffic authorities regarding conditions at the intersection of Church Street and Curtis Road.

Ald. Wyner had been dissatisfied with the reply of the Police Traffic Branch to Council representations for the installation of stop signs at the intersection.

The police had replied that signs were not needed as the intersection was of the normal type, presenting no unusual features.

There was good visibility, said the police, and the accident history of the intersection had been satisfactory.

Ald. Wyner said there was a tendency for truck drivers going up the hill to keep going, thus presenting a hazard to cross traffic.

He asked that further representations be made for the installation of stop signs.

# BALMAIN ASSOCIATION TREE-PLANTING SCHEME

The Balmain Association has told Leichhardt Council in parts of Balmain, to beautify the suburb, at its cost that it is prepared to carry out a tree-planting campaign on its own cost.

This follows the advice by Council late last year that the state of Council finances at the moment precluded the carrying out of the scheme by the Council this financial year.

The suggestion by the Association last September was that Curtis Road could be nicely landscaped with trees. It asked for Council's

comment on the suggestion.

Following the Council's "no money" plea, the Association wrote recently that it had purchased 100 plane trees, and was willing to make these available for the purpose of implementing the scheme it had originally submitted to Council.

The Association asked

permission to carry out a tree-planting programme, the cost of it to be borne by the Association.

It said that the trees were at present being "grown on" by individual members in readiness for the next planting season, within the next three or four months.

The offer has been referred to the Municipal engineer, Mr G. A. Wilson, who will discuss it with Association representatives.

The President of The Balmain Association, Mr W. Haesler, told "The Link" that they had discussed the proposal with some district residents, who were most enthusiastic about it.

Some had promised to look after the trees when planted.

"There should be no cost at all to the Council", Mr Haesler said. "All we need is permission to go ahead and plant the trees.

"Curtis Street is most suitable for footpath tree planting. We are prepared also to extend the scheme to other suitable streets".

## Chemical Tanks

The Balmain Association is dissatisfied with the amount of landscaping being effected in the area of the Vincent Street chemical tank farm.

It has written to the operators, Terminals Ltd., recalling the company's promise to landscape the area and provide a children's playground.

Landscaping has commenced, but it would appear that only part of the area will be turfed.

The Association has asked the company whether any other landscaping is proposed, and whether the children's playground idea has been dropped.

Meanwhile, for security reasons, street lighting nearby has been greatly improved, but, in Mr Haesler's opinion, a glare problem has been created.

He thinks some attention should be given to this in view of possible traffic danger in Vincent and Stephen Streets.

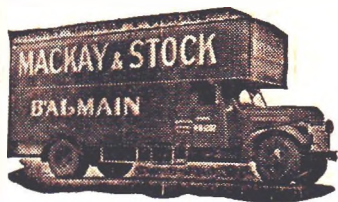
