# Association Is "Watchdog Of Residential Amenity"

**Determination to extend its role in the community and act as watchdog to prevent any destruction of residential amenity was the keynote of The Balmain Association, expressed at its annual general meeting last Thursday night.**

The meeting endorsed the reports of the President (Mr W. Haesler) and the various sub-committees, which indicated a great deal of important work during the past year on behalf of Balmain community interests.

In his report, Mr Haesler said that the aim of the Association in the coming year must be one of involvement.

"We must extend our role in the community", he said, "and act as watchdog to prevent any destruction of our residential amenity."

"We have the talent, the prestige and the support—all we need is enthusiastic assistance."

Mr Haesler said the Association had set about placing its views before everyone who had an interest in Balmain's future.

Leichhardt Council had remained typically unmoved, although the Association had had the usual sound relationship with the Balmain ward aldermen.

The Council had increased rates by a remarkable 30% without proper explanation. It had repeatedly ignored legitimate objections to

its own Planning Scheme and the advice of the State Planning Authority and pushed through undesirable development.

Council had ignored the pleas of residents regarding solutions to the road traffic problems generated by the container wharves, and had encouraged several undesirable developments in that direction.

Council had not honoured one election promise, except to set up three committees, none of which had given a hint about libraries, alleviation from pollution or any assistance regarding parking or traffic congestion.

It had, however, apparently agreed to the Association's tree planting scheme for Curtis Road.

"We can now at least talk to the Mayor and several of the 'majority', but so far without any effective liaison", Mr Haesler said.

"Home unit development has increased without any noticeable increase in architectural or civic planning standards, and we await precise details of the proposed East Balmain housing scheme. Will it be good

or be currently typical?"

Mr Haesler said that Balmain people seemed to be a little tired of "protests", and "action" during 1970-71 might be the key word.

The proposed regular opening of the Watch House for public inspections should further extend their aims.

Community involvement in other fields was also being planned, and approaches had been made to co-operate with other community groups in common projects.

The Balmain chapter of the Junior Chamber of Commerce had already advised that it was willing to hold an early meeting of the two groups.

**Pollution**

The meeting discussed several matters affecting Balmain, including its attitude towards storage of petrol in the Vincent Street "tank farm", and the proposed State legislation on pollution.

It considered the proposed legislation would not be tough enough and that it should be given more "teeth" to handle the problem.

## TREES IN FOOTPATHS

Residents of Rozelle and Balmain will appreciate an extensive tree-planting effort being conducted by Leichhardt Council in a number of streets in the district.

So far about 100 advanced trees have been planted, with a view to bringing beauty to the street scene, and shade during summer.

The trees being planted are of the Claret Ash variety, a deciduous tree whose leaves turn a rich wine shade in the early autumn.

The Claret Ash is reported to be particularly suitable for the footpaths of this area, being of fairly upright growth and quick growers.

A number of them are already to be seen flourishing in some Balmain streets, particularly Grafon Street and Duke Street, East Balmain.

In the early stages they will need watering at least once or twice a week, and it is reported that some help from residents in this direction would be appreciated by the Council staff.

## Rotaract Club Activity

Balmain Rotaract Club is now working out its programme of international and community services, and a report on these should be available shortly.

This club was formed recently.

Persons eligible are young men and women aged between 17 and 25, who live, work or study within the territorial limits of the sponsoring Rotary Club.

The Rotary Club provides guidance and counsel to the Club through a committee of members.

A Rotaract Club involves its members in carrying out a balanced programme of activity, which includes at least one major project annually in each of its three major fields of work.

These are vocational, community and international.

About two-thirds of Balmain Rotaract Club are local residents. The remainder work locally.

The Club has already

performed one community service—helping the newly-formed kindergarten being operated by the Balmain Children's Playgroup.

The help consisted of practical work in building a fence, painting walls, making bookshelves, repairing and painting cupboards and furniture, etc.

## School Fete Success

Balmain Public School's fete on August 15 was most successful.

The organising committee expresses its thanks to Balmain business people for their help and donations.

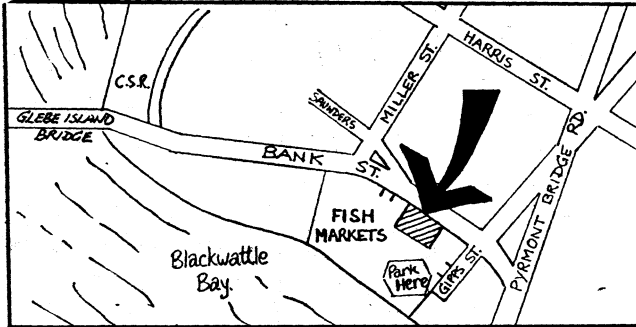

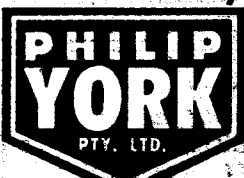
