

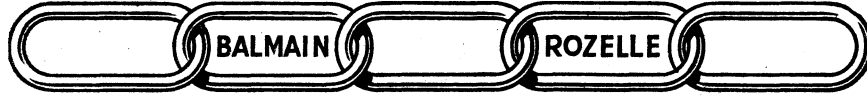

# Court Order To Remove Petrol From Tank Farm

**Terminals Pty. Ltd., operators of the Stephens Street (Balmain) chemical tank "farm", have been ordered by the Equity Court to remove from their land all petrol stored there. The court order followed an application by Leichhardt Council for an injunction against the company's storage of petrol.**

Judgment on the Council's injunction application was delivered on September 18 by Mr Justice Hope. It included the following:

"The Court declares that the use by the defendant of the land situate at the south-western corner of the intersection of Stephen and Vincent Streets, Balmain . . . for the purpose of the storage of petrol contravenes the provisions of the County of Cumberland Planning Ordinance and of any consent given by the plaintiff thereunder.

"The Court declares that the use by the defendant of the structures on the land . . . for the purpose of the storage of petrol contravenes the provisions of the County of Cumberland Planning Scheme Ordinance and any consent given by the plaintiff thereunder.

"The Court restrains the defendant by its servants and agents from using the land . . . and the structures thereon for the purpose of the storage of petrol without the consent of the plaintiff first had and obtained.

"The Court orders the defendant to remove from the land . . . all petrol stored thereon. Order for costs. Injunction suspended as note in judgment".

The final six words referred to the Court's decision that the petrol was to be removed by December 11, 1970.

This was to be done unless the company first made application to Council to vary the conditions for use of the

land, so as to permit the storage of petrol and, in the event of the Council refusing, to give time for the company to lodge an appeal with the Land and Valuation Court.

In reporting this judgment to Leichhardt Council at its last meeting the Council Solicitors, Pike, Pike and Fenwick, said it would be recalled that there was grave doubt in the Council's mind as to whether or not the development originally proposed should be allowed and that it was only with misgivings and under stringent conditions that Council came to its decision.

Council received and noted the correspondence.

### Amendment Rejected

It rejected an amendment moved by Ald. Wyner, seconded by Ald. Graham (Balmain ward), in the following terms:

"That the correspondence from Pike, Pike and Fenwick, Council's solicitors, re judgment in Council v. Terminals Pty. Ltd., be received.

"That Council record that its original approval of the Terminals' application rested, among other considerations, on advice from Council's Solicitors that 'one is faced with the zoning considerations . . . and the big risk that the land may be left sterile. This, we fear, is Council's biggest hurdle and on the balance reduces Council's chances of success in the event of any appeal to

something less than even' . . .

"This opinion being later refuted by the view expressed by Mr Justice Hardie which (according to the executive of the Local Government Association) made it evident that there is no doubt at all about Council's power to refuse an application on the grounds of general public interest, even though it be a perfectly legal and legitimate application in accordance with the town plan;

"And that Council also note that the 'grave doubt' and 'misgivings' resided not with the Council but the citizens of Balmain and their ward representatives, such feelings being borne out by the arrogant disregard for Council's conditions of approval displayed by the company in the present matter."

## RAG DRIVE FOR HOSPITAL BY LOCAL CHURCHES

People from many churches in Balmain, Rozelle and Lilyfield will be banding together on October 10 and 17 for a rag collection, whose proceeds will support the Balmain Hospital Appeal for funds for building a new Outpatients' - Casualty Department.

Next Saturday, October 10, bags will be taken from house to house, and the householders asked to keep them for one week, placing in them unwanted rags and worn-out clothing.

On Saturday week, October 17, the filled bags will be collected with the help of hospital and other vehicles.

Anyone interested in assisting this effort, whether connected with a particular local church or not, will be very welcome, and their help will be gratefully received.

At this stage the area to be attempted is that bounded by Victoria Road, and Evans, Mul-lens and Booth Streets. Whether or not this can

be covered fully will depend on the number of volunteering assistants.

The central point from which helpers will go out is Balmain Gospel Chapel, corner Darling and High Streets.

Anyone who can give some time on either day (even if only an hour) should report there any time after 9 a.m.

Arranged by Balmain-Rozelle Inter-Church Council, this effort is a practical expression of Christian concern for the community's welfare.

## VISITOR TO ROTARIANS

Balmain Rotary Club last week received an official visit from the Governor of Rotary District No. 275—Mr D. G. Sam Downie.

The area he presides over includes Sydney, and extends to the far South Coast of N.S.W.

Mr Downie, a chartered engineer, is Managing Director of a group of Sydney companies, and a past Federal President of the Australian Institute of Management.

He spoke about the Rotary International convention which will be held in Sydney in May next year.

For the first time since the formation of Rotary 50 years ago the convention will be held in Australia, and it is anticipated that 12,000 Rotarians will attend it.

"It will be a wonderful opportunity for Australians to play host to their overseas visitors," said Mr Downie.

The District Governor listed some of the fine organisations existing in this State which had been conceived and sponsored by the efforts of Rotarians.

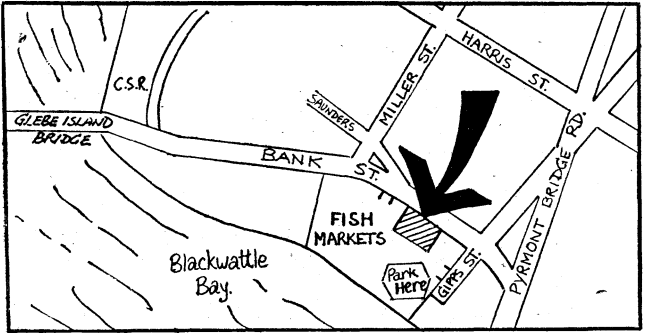

# GARDEN COMPETITION SHOULD GIVE BALMAIN A FACELIFT

With keen gardeners working on final aspects of their programme of spring care, a pleasing picture should develop as a result of the enterprise of The Balmain Association in conducting a district garden competition.

The Association is now receiving entries from competitors, who are being asked to complete the official entry form (copy of which appears on this page)

President of the Association, Mr W. Haesler, stressed that residents with only modest gardens should not be reticent about entering them in the competition.

"Our aim in holding this competition," he said, "is to give the dis-

trict a visual lift. Hence anyone who enters and puts some work into his or her garden will help that cause.

"Also an inspection of the winning gardens will be held soon after the contest, and we expect many people to come to Balmain to look at them.

"On such an occasion we would like Balmain to be looking its best, and a large entry of gardens will ensure this."

Mr Haesler added that they would also like to see as many people as possible join in the inspection day, as proceeds from it would go to Balmain Hospital's new building fund appeal.

Closing date for entry—which is free—will be October 31, but earlier entry would be appreciated to assist in the organisation of judging.

The competition is open to any resident or premises, public park and garden in Balmain, Balmain East, Birchgrove and Rozelle, in the area situated on the northern side of Victoria Road.

The entry form should be completed and forwarded to Garden Competition, C/- The Balmain Association, P.O. Box 57, Balmain, 2041.

There are five sections:

**Section 1:** Private gardens, either in front of or behind homes—(a) over 600 sq. ft. in area; (b) less than 600 sq. ft.

**Section 2:** Paved courtyards, any size (pot plants would be the main feature).

**Section 3:** Miscellaneous (covering window boxes, balcony gardens, ferneries, and treatment of laneways, easements, etc.)

**Section 4:** Industrial areas and home unit areas whose gardens are visible to passers-by.

**Section 5:** Public Parks and gardens.

The judges will inspect independently all areas in Sections 4 and 5, no entries being required, although advice from managements would be appreciated.

Prizes will be an engraved plaque in each section, plus a cash prize in Sections 1, 2 and 3.

## FACELIFT FOR P.O. CLOCK

Post Office engineers are giving the historic Balmain Post Office clock a two-weeks' rest to enable renovations to be carried out.

The clock which was supplied by A. Tornaghi, was officially put in motion on June 21, 1887.

It still has the original dials and numerals, and remains mechanically sound.

However, it is in need of a complete overhaul. Post Office engineers expect the work to take about 14 days (from last Tuesday).

During this time they will replace the face, renumber the dials and help provide better lighting for night-time.

The lighting system will spread over the whole of the dial and leave none of it in shade.

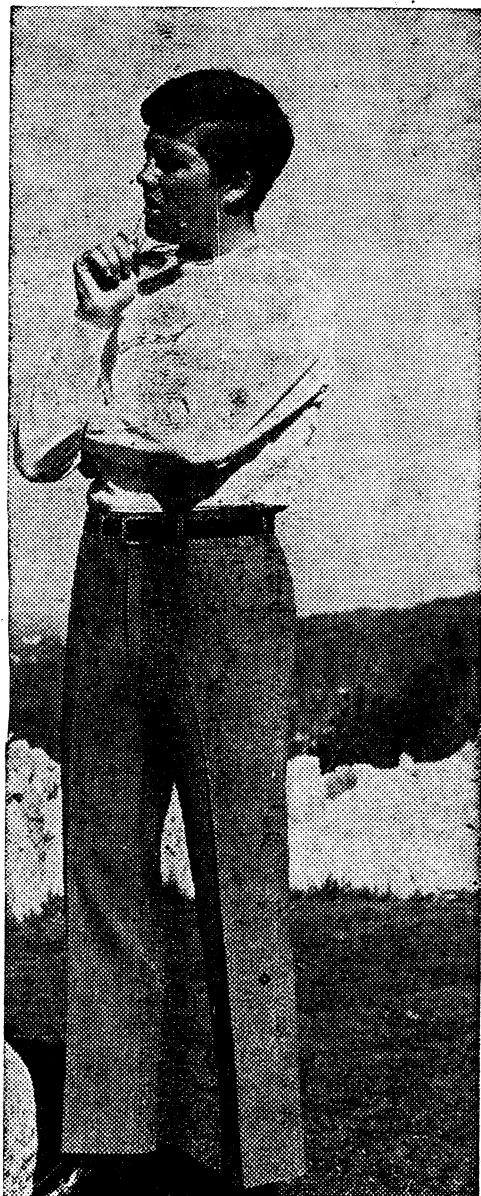
