

A telephone call from "The Link" to the Water Board last week saw repaired within 24 hours a footpath fire hydrant in Darling Street, Bal-main, which had been leaking for weeks.

Green slime had formed on the footpath, and it was not a pretty sight.

The spot is close to the fire station, police station, Post Office, Town Hall, and important private business premises.

Our informant urged us to publish the facts without reporting the matter to the Board, but we felt that a sense of civic responsibility de-manded direct action.

The incident calls for answers to several questions:

• Since the period of the leak was a matter of weeks, why was it not picked up by the Board's own staff, especially since it occurred in a central position in Balmain's main thoroughfare?

• Was not the leak seen by any employee of other Government authorities with headquarters nearby?

• Thousands of ordinary citizens must have walked past the spot during the period of the leak. Did any one (including occupiers of nearby business premises) take the trouble to report it to the Board?

Some people believe that reporting such conditions is not the duty of an ordinary citizen. This we feel is wrong. We suggest that a citizen cannot divorce himself from some sense of responsibility in these matters.

The incident, of course, is only minor, but minor incidents at times develop into major ones.

This is our community, and its interests should be protected in every way possible. A greater sense of awareness of one another's comfort would seem to be called for.


