# MOVE FOR BETTER LANDSCAPING FOR HOME UNITS

The Balmain Association is conducting a campaign among its members designed to improve the landscaping of new blocks of home unit sites in Balmain.

In its monthly newsletter it is urging them to take action to object to the lack of landscaping in particular developments.

The newsletter says: "Ugly home units on sites covered with concrete or bitumen for car parking are the major threat to the scale and character of this area.

"Aesthetic quality cannot be written into building regulations, and you can do nothing about the appearance of these buildings.

"But the landscaping of sites can and, as the subject of legislation, ought to be enforced.

"Council regulations stipulate that at least 25 per cent of the site of a three-storey flat building shall be landscaped, but this regulation is not being enforced.

"You can take positive action by phoning or writing to the Council Engineer or Town Planner, enquiring or object-

ing to the lack of landscaping in particular developments.

"Trees and other plantings are the only way of at least half disguising these disastrous buildings. Let the Council know what you feel about it".

## S.P.A. ACT COMMENDED

President of the Association, Mr W. Haesler, said the other day that the State Planning Authority of N.S.W. was to be commended on its stand regarding waterfront zoning in Balmain.

Mr Haesler was referring to the purchase by the Authority of the Morrison and Sinclair shipbuilding property at Long Nose Point in order to convert it into an area for public recreation.

The S.P.A. said its decision was an acknowledgment of the need in this area for public access to the waterfront.

The purchase was being made in accordance with the Government's policy of releasing harbour foreshore land for public use when it became available and when it was possible to use it for that purpose.

Mr Haesler said that this attitude followed other actions which the Association had appreciated.

The S.P.A. had lately made objections to certain building and town planning developments, and the Association wholeheartedly supported its stand.

The Longnose Point move was another instance of the S.P.A. at last taking a sensible and realistic look at Balmain.

## Semi-nudity In Public

This paper has drawn to the attention of the Balmain police some complaints it has received of instances of male exhibitionism in main streets of the suburb.

It is feared these could be the start of an era of exhibitionism.

One offender, a young man "dressed" in a pair of revealing briefs and nothing else, was seen making a purchase in a prominent store.

It's probable, of course, that the exhibitionists believe they are committing no wrong, this suburb having a popular swimming pool and a public beach.

And there's a pretty thin line at times between decency and indecency in swim suits.

Still, in a main shopping area the public is expected to display a sense of propriety, and both shopkeepers and the public expect the support of the authorities in ensuring maintenance of propriety.

We realise exhibitionists might enjoy tussles with authority and that the police have to be careful in any official charge they make.

Courts have to take a completely responsible attitude in case of offensive behaviour.

We realise also that a revolution has taken place in the public approach to "permissiveness", which includes matters of dress (vide the mini and the long hair cult among men).

Nevertheless there is a limit to what ordinary folk can swallow.

Hence a firm (quiet) word to those who are obviously overstepping bounds in our suburb is called for. It could well put a stop to exhibitionism, or at least prevent its spread.

## AIRCRAFT NOISE

In an effort to ease the problem of aircraft noise in its area, Leichhardt Council has decided to ask the Kingsford Smith Airport Noise Abatement Committee to press for diversion to runway 34 of aircraft now normally using runway 16.

This would be for both arriving and departing aircraft.

Council adopted a recommendation to this effect from its Municipal Health Surveyor and

Building Inspector, Mr R. S. Williams.

Mr Williams reported that the flight path used by aircraft traversing Leichhardt Municipality was to and from runway 16.

He said that the noise was unbearable.

The density of population in Leichhardt, together with the number of hospitals and schools directly under the flight path, warranted serious consideration of this suggestion.

# Committee To Hear Local Views On Waterfront Moves

**Local views are to be considered by the Maritime Services Board in future before deciding on applications for permission to erect structures on land in the Port of Sydney below high water mark.**

This decision would have application to matters like the commercial marina proposal which has been exercising residents and authorities alike in the Balmain area.

Leichhardt Council has accepted an invitation by the Maritime Services Board to participate in a body it is forming in an amendment to its administrative practices.

The Deputy Mayor, Ald. McMahon, will act as the Council's representative on the body, which is to be known as

the Foreshores Committee.

The committee will comprise one representative of the Board, one of the State Planning Authority of N.S.W., and one of the local Council concerned.

The matters to be dealt with are applications to the Board for permission to erect on its land wholly below high water mark in the Port of Sydney boatsheds and other buildings of a similar nature, and any other proposals which in the Board's opinion involve aspects

## WORK ON NEW CLUB FOR R.S.L.

Excavations have been completed and foundations laid for the new club house being built for Balmain - Rozelle R.S.L. Club.

Secretary of the Sub-branch, Mr R. Jones, said construction should go ahead quickly now.

He said that satisfactory arrangements had been made for financing the venture.

Estimated to cost about \$570,000, the new building is expected to be in use by the end of this year.

It will provide greatly increased facilities for the use of members and their guests, and is expected to produce a 50 per cent increase in membership.

The new building will comprise three floors and a basement, and provide 50 badly-needed parking spaces in a section of Darling Street notoriously short of parking room.

The committee will consider and furnish views on the applications, whereupon the Board will make its decision.

The committee will be competent to consider each application in the light of any County or local Planning Scheme, aesthetics, availability of parking space for vehicles in the immediate locality, effect if any on the amenity of the neighbourhood, and generally to have regard to local knowledge and background association by each member.

Navigational implications, however, are expressly excluded from the committee's consideration.
