The detalled stud living conditions by Leichhardt Council prior to adoption of a home unit construc tion is a wise step.
The former Coun cil's attitude was like that of so many other Councils in the Sydney area - pecemea rd action without thought of an overal picture.
This produced mixed policy, uncer tainty among develop ers and the public and occasional quar planning authorities.

The study will a east put before Coun cil a complete picture of existing conditions wit hout having to await detailed report when development ap considered.
And it will enable full consideration of he facts to be given right away so that
Council can lay down co-ordinated policy in particular areas.
While the ultimat permanent code could possibly produce heart-burning among property owners and developers, if regard ed as too restrictive,
at least the public and developers should know where they stood.
Nothing so far has been said about resi dents' participation in the study.
A simple survey form dropped in res dents' letterboxe would enable them to express their view now, without waiting until a developmen application offensive o them for a particu ar reason was being considered
