

Man charged following hospital fire

\$50,000 damage report

Initial reports indicate that the fire damage to Balmain Hospital's operating theatres could be as high as \$50,000 — but a final figure is not expected for several weeks at least.

Local library soon?

Balmain is almost certain to benefit from having a municipal library in 1975 — particularly if the mayor, Alderman Les Rodwell, has his way.

Alderman Rodwell told 'The Link' there will 'definitely' be extensions to the central library next year, "and we are hoping for further extensions in the following year."

Alderman Rodwell added: "It would seem probable, and I certainly hope it is, that there could be another branch established next year — and the logical place to extend this to is Balmain."

The hospital's chief executive officer, Mr Arthur Dower, said this week he had been provided with interim reports which suggested the construction damage could be up to \$30,000 with equipment damage as high as \$20,000.

Charged
Meanwhile, Balmain detectives have charged a 20-year-old local resident in connection with the fire.

He has been remanded without bail to Balmain Police Court on December 17 to face two charges of breaking, entering and stealing.

Repair work on the two damaged operating theatres is reported to be on schedule, Mr Dower said these would be in use by next week as planned.

The major theatre suite on the ground floor of the hospital will not, however, be in use for at least a month.

'ART IN THE SUN'

Students at St Augustine's School in Balmain's Eaton Street recently enjoyed their art class in the sun — or at any rate the shade — when student teacher Dorothy Jaksic introduced them to "space patterns".

The idea, they found, was to put a blob of ink on a piece of paper and blow it — forming such forms as spacemen and spaceships — and even just space.

Dorothy was "on loan" from the Guild Teachers' College in Ultimo, where teachers for private schools get their training.

Bijou to be opened this week

Balmain is to get its Bijou theatre back this week — after a break of several years.

The theatre is to open today with a special "pensioners' preview" afternoon showing of "The Desert Song" — and begins its first season with a special premiere of Charlton Heston in "Anthony and Cleopatra".

Also on the coming billings will be "Blood For Dracula" an "in" art film which has been highly regarded in some quarters.

Both films will be premiered in Balmain.

Last Tuesday, Leichhardt Council provided the theatre with its final go-ahead by deciding to grant a 12-month cinema certificate to the management — with certain conditions attached.

Doubts whether the theatre would open on time arose some weeks ago when opposition to the re-introduction of a major theatre to Balmain was made by nearby residents in North Street and the Police Traffic Branch.

At a council works inspection held on site last week, the theatre's Administrative manager, Mr John Love, and the film manager, Mr Ribert Coutts, undertook that:

- The theatre would be a "cultural acquisition" to the district.
- Parking problems

would be minimal as 50 parking spaces had been arranged at the Esso Garage in Darling Street.

- Noise would be kept to a minimum.

The Bijou is, in reality, the old National Theatre, which first opened in 1913 for the Australian stage show "Robbery Under Arms" and was then used for films until its closure after World War II.

Nuisance

Mr Love said the management intended to ask patrons to make as little noise as possible when going to and leaving the theatre, and to park without causing any public nuisance.

"Afternoon sessions will be no trouble as they will be devoted to children's films," he told 'The Link'. "And we have photographs which show very little traffic on the streets at night."

"The parking we have provided, together with other parking available, should mean no added traffic or parking congestion."

In fact, film-going for local people is expected to be much more convenient over the Christmas holidays when children's films will be shown in the afternoon, with adult showings at night.
